



By virtue of two warrants one of them dated the 21<sup>st</sup> February 1752 the other dated the 22<sup>d</sup> March 1753 surveyed the 12<sup>th</sup> of September 1783 to Lodowick Richart the two above described tracts of land situate in Weiss-enburgh township Northampton County containing in both tracts one hundred and thirty four acres three quarters & the allowance of six P cent &c<sup>d</sup>
