



A draught of a tract of land called the Landing Place situate on the southerly side of the west branch of Susquehanna about half a mile up a large run which empties into the river about five miles & an half below the Carroe Rivl adjoining land of Benjamin Trapnall & Richard Edwards and near land of Mary Jenkins Junr in the County of Bedford containing three hundred & three acres & the usual allowance of six P cent for roads &c surveyed the 3^d day of November 1775 for Mary Roberts in pursuance of a warrant dated the 3^d day of August 1773 by
