



*In pursuance of an order from the commissioner of property dated the 16<sup>th</sup> day of June 1772 a survey was made on the 3<sup>d</sup> day of July 1772 for John Steel Junr on a certain lot of ground situate in the town of Sunbury in the County of Northumberland marked in a general plan of said town number one hundred and thirty four containing in breadth east and west on Dewberry street sixty feet and in length north and south two hundred and thirty feet bounded northward by Dewberry Street Eastward by lot number number hundred and thirty three Southward by Mulberry Alley and westward by lot number one hundred and thirty five returned into the Secretarys office the 26<sup>th</sup> day of September 1776 for Daniel Rees*
