



By virtue of a warrant dated the 1st of December Anno Domini 1737 the above described tract of land was surveyed to John Rippeth in Hanover township in Lancaster County beginning at a white oak a corner of James Rippeth thence north 60 degrees east by the improvement of John Snoddy & John Burtin 134 pche^s to a spanish oak thence by the improvement of Joseph Rippeth the three following courses viz N 33 deg^s EAST 62 per^s to a post and NORTH NORTH EAST 56 per^s to a white oak and NORTH 30 P to a white oak & corner of James Wright (1st 9^{mo} 1739)
