



By virtue of a warrant dated the twenty fifth day of November 1735 surveyed the 17<sup>th</sup> day of June 1785 to Christian Reeser in right of Wooly Reeser the above described tract of land situate in Heidelberg township Lancaster County containing two hundred and forty eight acres and three quarters of an acre and the allowance of six Percent for roads &c.
