



The draught of a tract of land situate in <sup>#</sup>Northumberland County within the last purchase made of the Indians on a large run running into Sugar Creek on the north side of 5<sup>d</sup> Creek about two miles from the mouth of 5<sup>d</sup> Creek adjoining Coll. Porters other lands surveyed August 3<sup>d</sup> day A.D. 1786 for Coll. Andrew Porter on warrant N<sup>o</sup> 720 & dated Nov. 26<sup>th</sup> in the year 1785 containing five hundred forty seven acres & seventy four perches & allowance of six P cent for roads &c.
