



A draught of a tract of Land Surveyed the 16<sup>th</sup> day of November for George Miller 1808<sup>A</sup> by virtue of his Virginia Certificate as follows (to wit) April 22<sup>d</sup> 1780, George Miller produced certificate from the Commissioners for adjusting and settling claims to lands in the Counties Yohogania Monongalia and Ohio for four hundred Acres of Land in this County on Mingo Creek to include his Settlement made in the year 1774. which entry I have entered &c. I do hereby certify that the above is a true copy of the Entry as it stands on the Books of Entries of Certificates for Yohogania County delivered to me by Doct<sup>r</sup> Benjamin Johnston Given under my hand the 25<sup>th</sup> October 1808.
