



Pursuant to a Warrant dated the 13th day of October 1806 Surveyed on the 23rd day of April 1807 to John Mallowny the above described Island situate in the River Delaware (bounded by low water mark) called Mallowny's Island near to the South West point of the Mouth of the River Schuylkill and Opposite to State Island situate in Kingsess Township in the County of Philadelphia Containing one acre three quarters and twenty seven perches.
