



A draught of a tract of land situate in Hopewell Township  
 Feby.  
 in the County of York Resurveyed the 19<sup>th</sup> 1798 by the lines formerly  
 run by William Kersey Late Deputy Surveyor in pursuance of a war-  
 rant to Alexander Ramsey dated the 10<sup>th</sup> day of May 1786 Containing  
 in the whole two hundred and eighty eight acres & eighty four perches  
 and the usual allowance of six acres P. Cent for roads.

N. B. the part where the letter A. is placed contains two hundred  
 & three acres & 23 P<sup>s</sup> & the piece where the letter B. is placed con-  
 tains eighty five acres & 61 perches, now separated as is above de-  
 scribed agreeably to the sale thereof.
