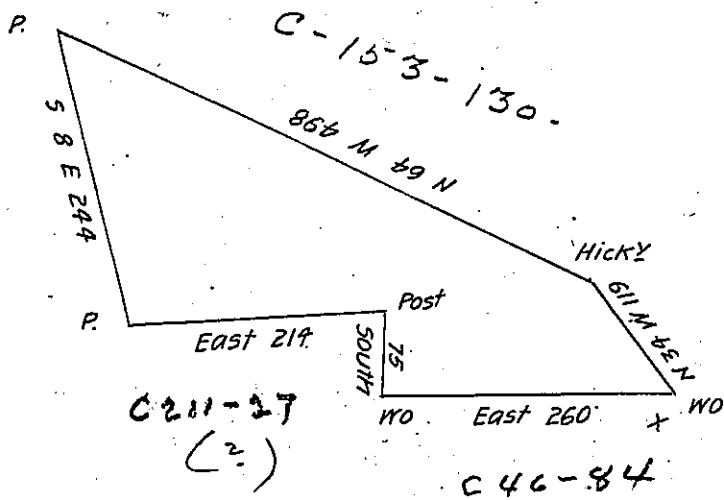

The above is the draught of a survey made December 19<sup>th</sup> 1794 in pursuance of a warrant granted to Elizabeth Roberdeau on the 14<sup>th</sup> day of April 1792 Situate northwest of the Ohio River on the waters of Beaver Creek, adjoining land granted to Charles Risk called Dingwall- Containing 427 Acres with the usual allowance of 6 P<sup>r</sup> Cent &c
