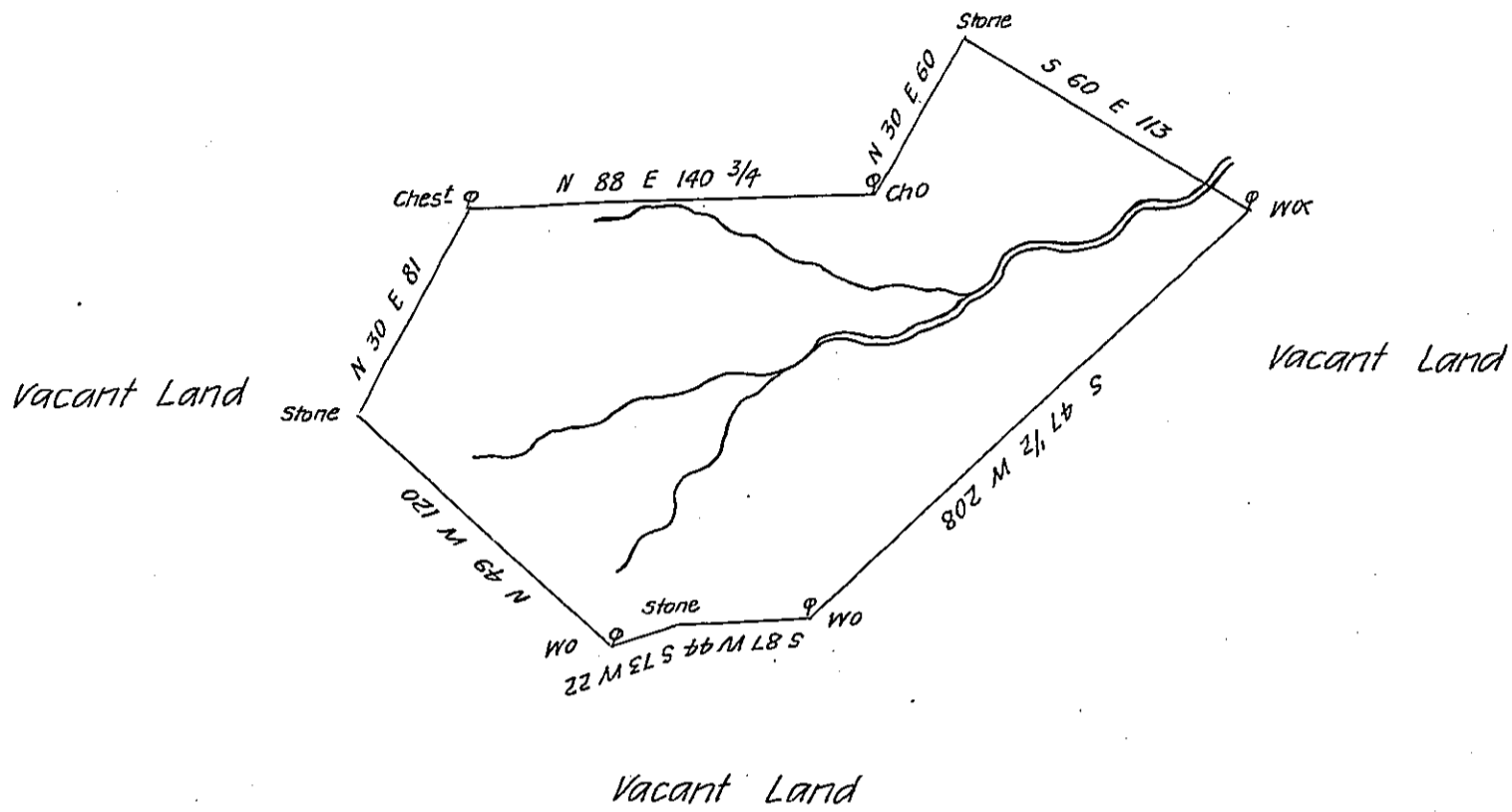


Vacant Land



By virtue of a warrant dated the 7<sup>th</sup> December 1785  
 Surveyed the 5<sup>th</sup> November 1790 to John Muschb<sup>er</sup> the above  
 described tract of land situate on the head waters of Larnskaughs  
 Creek about three quarters of a mile from Delaware River in  
 Upper Smithfield Township Northampton County containing one hun-  
 dred and ninety one acres three quarters and the allowance of six  
 P. Cent &c<sup>a</sup>
