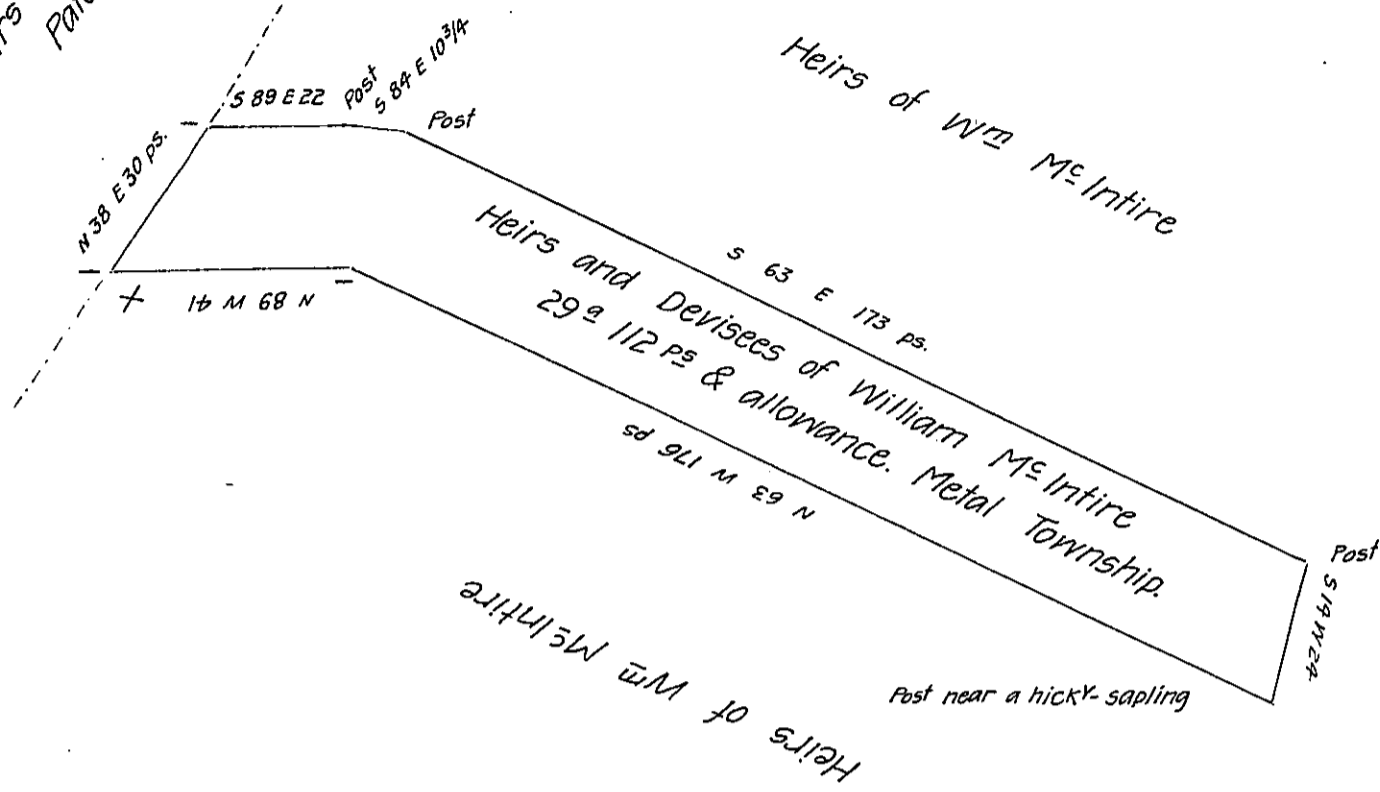


Heirs of Wm McIntire

The above described tract of Twenty nine acres, one hundred and twelve perches of land and allowance is part of a larger tract of Two hundred and forty acres and an half acre of land and allowance, situate in Metal Township (formerly Fannet) Franklin County, which was surveyed to William McIntire the 27th day of March 1793 in pursuance of an Order of Survey dated the 27th day of October 1766, No 1685; resurveyed and divided off the 19th day of April 1808.
