Situate in Orumore Township, Lancaster County.

Being parts of a larger Tract, Surveyed in pursuance of a Warrant, granted to John Robinson, bearing Date the 21 st March A.D. 1794. Surveyed the above described two pieces of Land, for the Administrators of John Robinson, Deceased the 8 th Day of March 1830-as part of the Estate of Said Deceased.
