

The above is a draft of a tract of land Situate in Springfield Township Mercer County numbered in the general draft of the 3d district donation Land four hundred and ninety one. Said to be an undrawn tract.

Surveyed the 15th day of May 1827 agreeably to the lines and Marks on the ground. In pursuance of the Actual Settlement Residence and improvement of Robert Reed, who was residing there on with his family at the time it was Surveyed. Containing two hundred and fourteen acres and 139 perches and allowance of Six percent for roads. Setled in the fall of 1815. Improvement is a House Sufficient for the habitation of Man, a good Barn, and at least thirty acres of land Cleared and Cultivated.— Bounded as above.
