



By Virtue of a warrant dated the 30<sup>th</sup> July 1793 Surveyed 31<sup>st</sup> March 1795 by George Palmer for Eliza Roberts the above described Tract of land situate on the branches of Blomingrove-Creek in the county of Northampton (now pike) containing four hundred and one Acres Sixty perches and the allowance of Six per Cent &c.

Examined and approved this 26<sup>th</sup> day of February 1825.
