



The above is a draught of a Survey made for George Ross the 16th day of May A^o.D^o. 1816 in pursuance of a Warrant dated the 20th of September 1810. being an Island in the Allegheny River About One Mile below Kittanning in Armstrong County. Containing ten Acres & Ninety Nine perches and Allowance of Six p. Cent for Roads &c. pr. Robt. Orr, Jr. Esqr. a former Depy. Surv^r. Taken from his draught now in my possession which I have examined and find Correct. Certified this 29th day of December A^o.D^o. 1823.
