Schuylkill county containing four hundred and one acres and ninety six perches and the allowance of six per Cent. said to have been surveyed on the 12 th day of May 1794 in pursuance of a warrant dated 19 th November 1793 granted Thomas Runyon as appears by an official copy of the return of Survey made into the Survey or Generals of fice. Resurveyed on the 8th September 1826 in pursuance of an Order of the Board of Property dated 30th day of March 1826.
