

By Virtue of an Order from the Board of Property bearing date the (ob!) day of November Anno Domini 1785. Survey'd unto Benjamin Light foot & Francis Parvin (now William Green Sen!) The above described Tract or piece of Land situate on the waters of big Schuylkill-in Schuylkill Township, Berks County. Containing Four Hundred and three Acres. one hundred & eleven perches and a llowance of six p Cent for Roads & ca.
