

The above is the draught of a Survey made December 8th 1794, in pursuance of a warrant granted to Jacob Miley on the 14th day of April 1792. Situate North West of the Ohio River on the waters of Beaver Creek, adjoining Land granted to Jonathan Mifflin, called Belevelt..... Containing 437 acres----- with the usual allowance of 6 pr. Cent &c.
