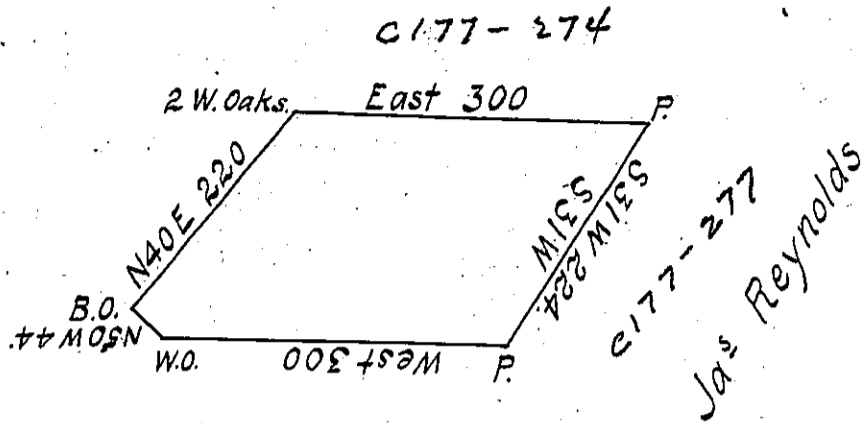

The above is the draught of a survey made December 20th 1794 in pursuance of a warrant granted to Daniel Richards on the 14th day of April 1792 situate Northwest of the Ohio river on the waters of Beaver Creek adjoining land granted to James Reynolds, Carver called Diest containing 376 acres and 96 perches with the usual allowance of 6 pCent &c^a.
