



Situate on Laurel Hill in Union and Wharton townships, Fayette County, and surveyed the 10<sup>th</sup> day of June 1836 in pursuance of a warrant in the name of Alexander Rop for 400<sup>as</sup> dated the 30<sup>th</sup> day of January, 1794. There are 30 or 40 acres cleared on this tract and two families thereon. The improvement is nearly 40 years old.
