



In persuance of Peter Young's improvement and settlement was surveyed on the ninth day of March A.D. 1814 the annexed described tract of land Containing 210<sup>as</sup> 133<sup>ps</sup> of Land and allowance of Land six p<sup>t</sup> Cent for Roads &c. it Being Lot. No 1599 in the Eighth District of Donation Lands situate in Roccail Township Crawford County, Pa. and having Reexamined the same on the ground and found it to be Correct and that the said Peter Young was Residing on the same with his family and there appered to be upwards of 30<sup>as</sup>. Cleared fenced and Cultivated June 5th. A.D. 1829.
