



In Pursuance of an Act of Gen.^l Assembly of the State of Pennsylvania passed the 24th day of Feb^y 1785 entitled "an Act for directing the Mode^o of Distributing the Donation Lands promised the Troops of this Common-Wealth" and by order of the Surveyor General with the Approbation of the Hon.^l the Executive Council, I have surveyed on the 29th day of July 1785 the Above discribed Tract of two Hundred Acres of Land and Allowance of Six PC^t for Roads &c. N° DCXCVII. Situate in District N° 4 on the West side of the Allegany River in the County of Westmoreland.
