



A Warrt. was granted to James Simony for 140<sup>as</sup> dated the 3<sup>d</sup> of Jan<sup>y</sup> 1733. Surveyed the 10<sup>th</sup> of the same month now Assigned to his son John Simony. James Simony's Warrt. vacated & another Warrt. granted the 22<sup>d</sup> of May 1740 to Return the land for the use of John Simony Returned &c. the same day.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this thirteenth day of September 1906.
