Survey may not interfere with John Robeson & Elders  
as returned. I have cast two Courses of Robesons into  
One as on Hockersmiths & this Draught, Viz, from the  
Ches! Oak at E to the Stones at F Course & Distance  
Calculated being 5. 52° W. 83.7 - on extending the Lines  
of Cochrans Maryland Survey, they interfered as appears  
on the General Plan. The Alteration is Represented  
by the Dotted Line on this Draught  
& which Reduces the Survey Returned, 20.859 P. & all.
