

Surveyed Land

A Draught of a Tract of Land called Cloverfield, situate on white Oak Run about half a Mile above where it empties into Conolloway Creek adjoining & below Lands of Peter Smith, in Bethel Township, in the County of Bedford. Containing two hundred & twenty three Acres and the usual Allowance of six & Cent for Roads & Surveyed the 18th Day of June 1774 for Adam Smith in pursuance of an Order No. 1767 Dated the 31st Day of October 1766, by
