



By Virtue of a Warrant dated the 18<sup>th</sup> day of December Anno Domini 1810, surveyed unto W<sup>m</sup> Ridge the above described Island situate in the River Delaware, Called "Resolution Island" opposite the Land of W<sup>m</sup> Ridge, on the Pennsylvania Shore in Tinicum Township, Bucks County. Containing ten acres and sixty nine perches and the usual allowance of six per Cent, this 27<sup>th</sup> day of December 1810.
