In Pursuance of an order from the Commissioner of Property dated the 16th day of June 1772, A survey was made the 3^d day of July 1772 for John Robb on a Certain Lot of ground Situate in the Town of Sunbury in the County of Northumberland marked in the General plan of Said Town N° Two hundred & Sixty Eight. Containing in breadth Sixty feet, East & West, and in length North & South Two hundred and Thirty feet. Bounded Southward by Poakberry Street, Eastward by Lot N° 267, Northward By Goosberry Alley, and Westward by River Alley. Returned into the Secretaries Office August 10th 1776, for Stephen Sutton by Warrant of the Ninth Instant —
