



In pursuance of a Warrant for 400 acs dated the 21th day of April 1794 was surveyed the 25th day of January 1817 for Daniel Rose the above discribed Tract of of Land Containing 392 acres, 74 perches & allow-
ance of six per cent for roads &c. and that the same was divided as above stated between Isaac Allee & Joseph Clark, the Assignees of the said Daniel Rose for the purpose of obtaining seperate patents & at the time of making said survey the above named Isaac Allee was in possession of the same and there appered to be upwards of 20 acres of land Clered and fenced and a house fit for the habitation of man
