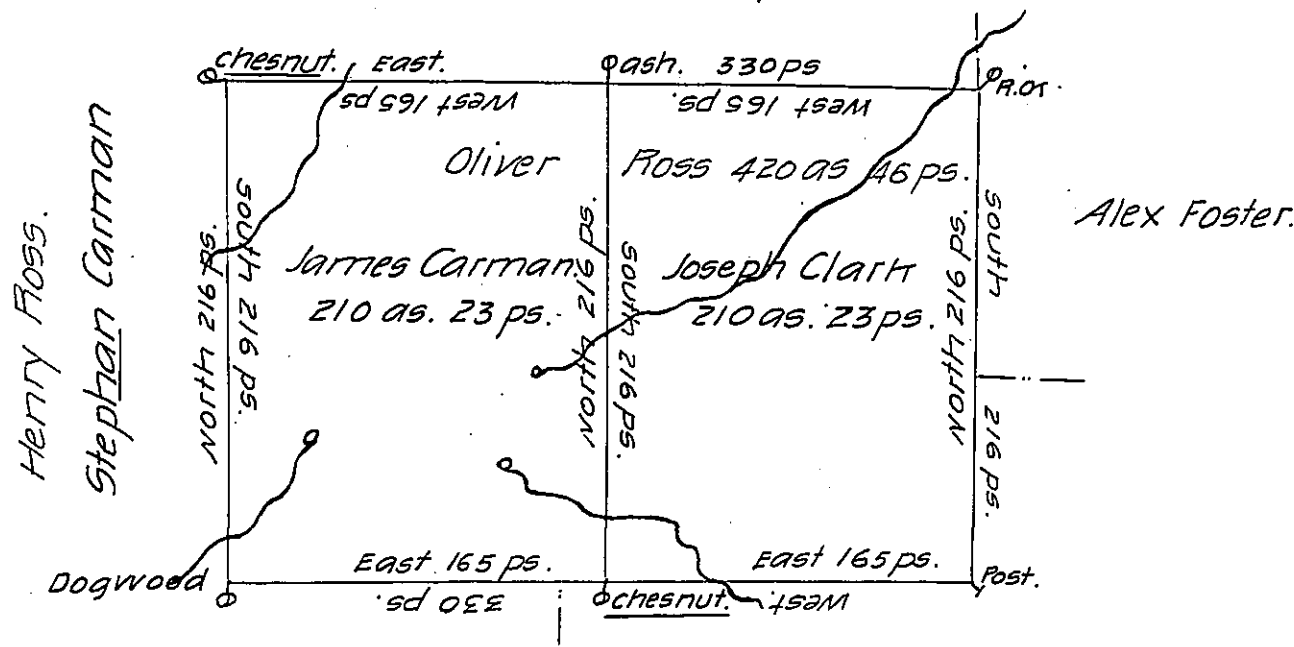

In Pursuance of a Warrant for 400 as. dated the 21th day of April A.D. 1794. was surveyed the 27th day of January 1817 for Oliver Floss, the above discribed Tract of Land containing Four hundred twenty acres forty six perches and allowance of Six per Cent. for Roads &c, and that the same <sup>was</sup> divided as above stated between James Carman & Joseph Clark the assignees of the said Oliver Floss, for the purpose of obtaining seperate Patents, & at the time of making said survey the above named James Carman was in possession of the same and he had a house fit for the habitation of man and there appeared to be upwards of 15 acres cleared and fenced. situate in Venango Township, Crawford County, Pennsylvania.
