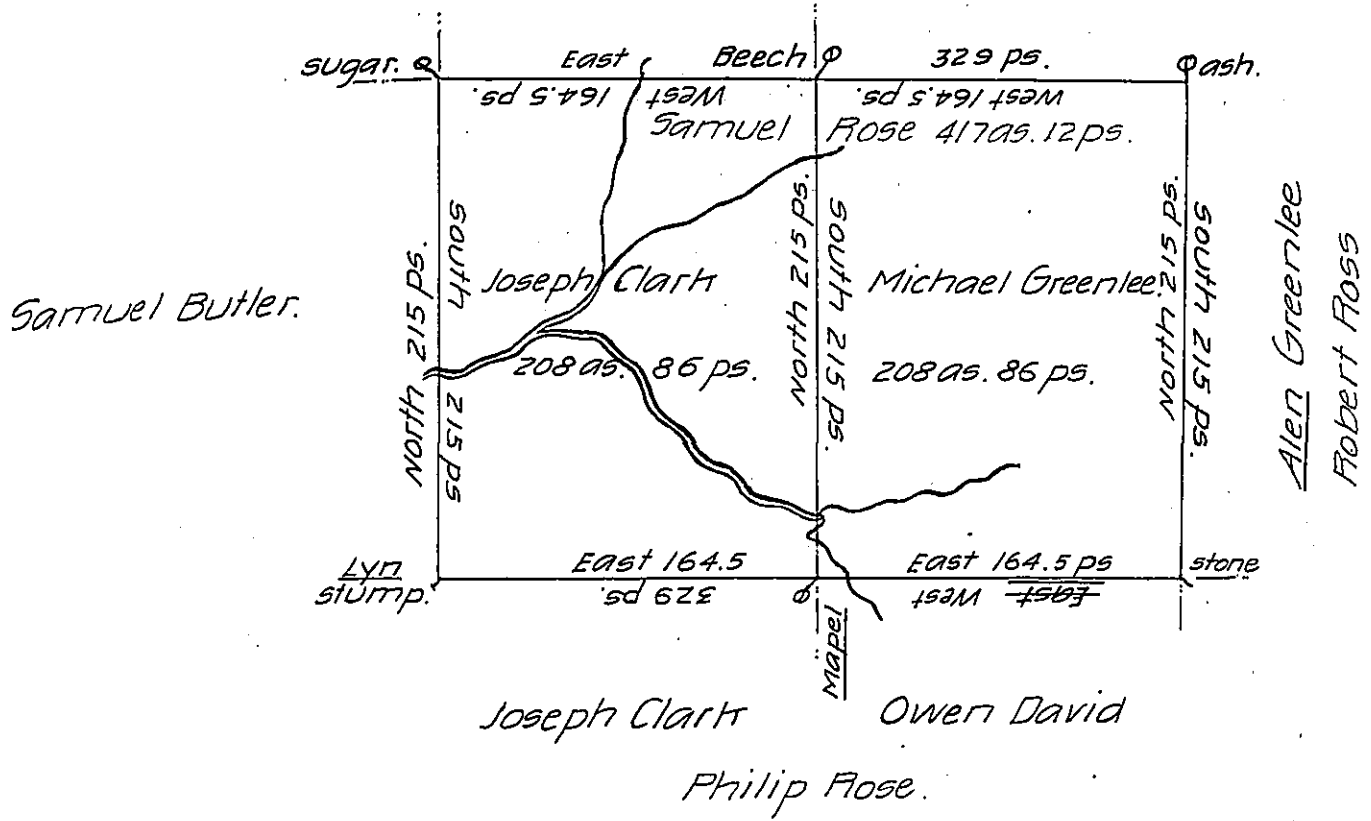

In Pursuance of a Warrant for 400 ac. dated the 21th day of April

A.D. 1794, was surveyed the 29th day of January 1817 for Samuel Fose the above discribed Tract of Land containing 417 acres 12 perches & allowance of six per cent for Roads &c. and that the same was devided as above stated, between Michael Greenlee and Joseph Clark the assignees of the said Samuel Fose for the purpose of obtaning seperate patents & at the time of making said survey the said michael Greenlee was in posesion of the of the same and there appered upwards of 30 acres of land clered and fenced & a house fit for the habitation of man. Situate in venango Township Crawford County, Pa.
