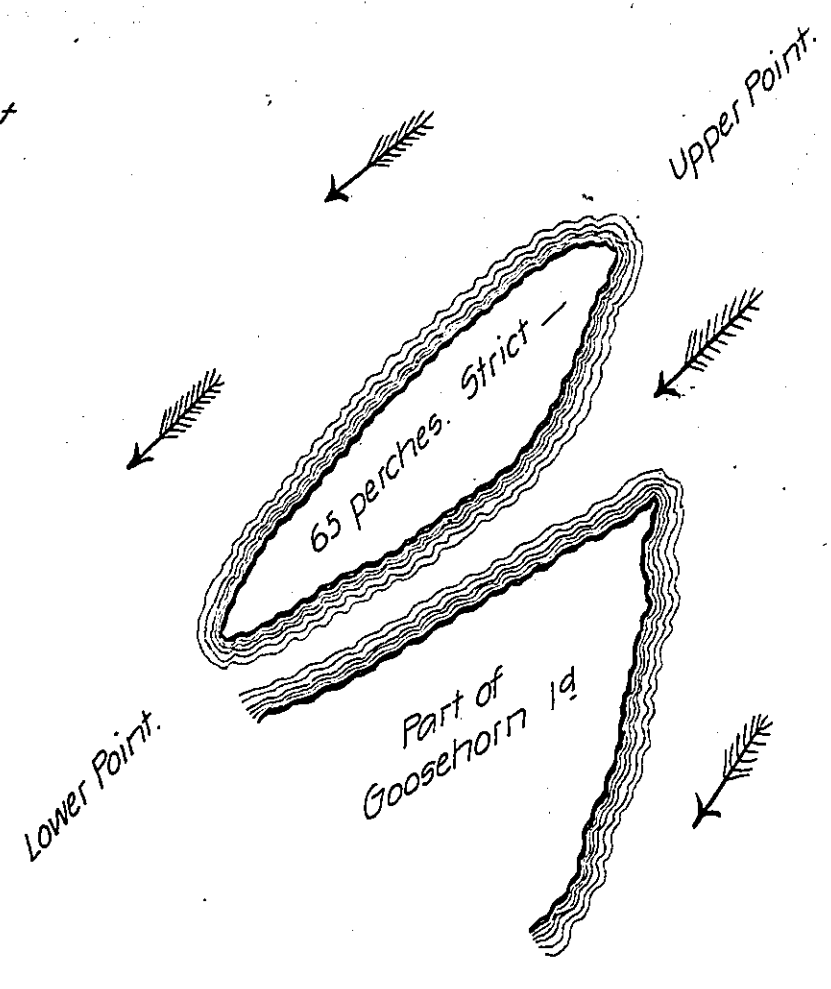

Surveyed May 31st 1815 for Melchoir Rahm Junr and John Lowman  
the above described Island situate in the River Susquehanna in Derry  
Township Dauphin County called "Sandy Island" about five perches South-  
ward from the Goosehorn Island and opposite to the Kill Island Con-  
taining Sixty five perches Strict measure by their Warrant dated the 22<sup>d</sup>  
day of May 1815.
