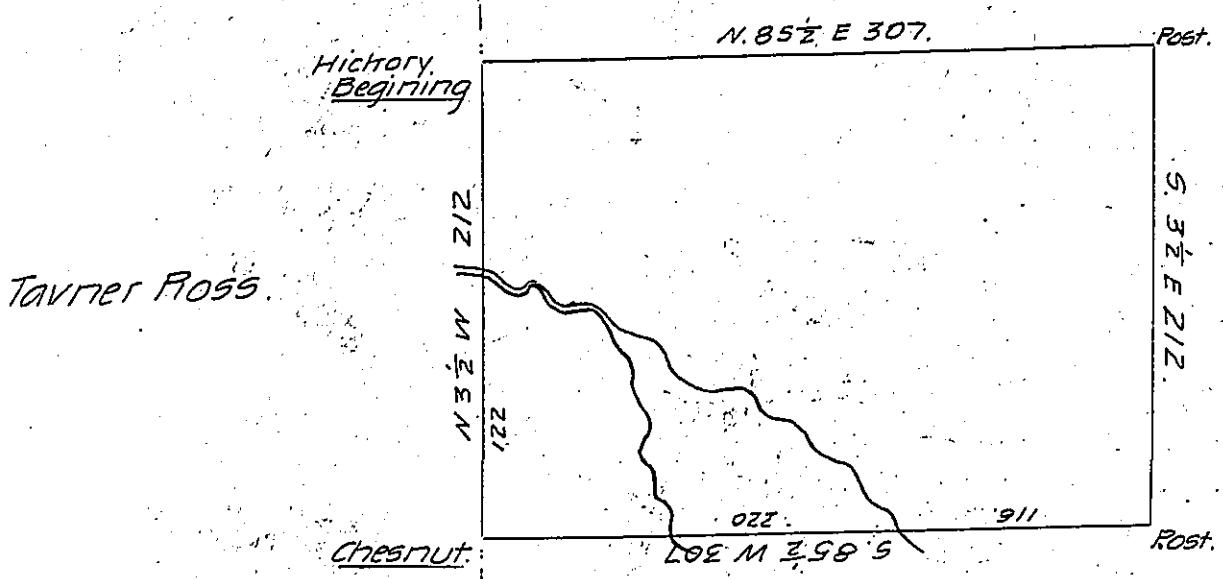

Executed August 30th 1815 on a Warrant granted to Elizabeth Farnsey in trust for herself & the heirs of Anthony Farnsey decd dated March 13th 1815 for 400 as Situate on the waters of Breachneck in Pine Township Allegheny County

At the time of Surveying the above Eliza Farnsey was residing thereon with her family had a square log dwelling house & a double barn & at least 25 acres of the above clear & in a state of cultivation the date of the improvements appeared such as was stated in her application on which the Warrt issued.
