



Draught of a Tract of Land Call'd — Situate on the Head waters of Warriors Run adjoining land of James Watts, Andrew Russel & others in Derry-formerly Turbutt Township in the County of Northumberland, Survey'd on the Eighth day of May 1786, for Joseph Allison in pursuance of his application No. 3605, bearing date the 5th day of July 1769. Containing Two Hundred & Fifty eight acres with the allowance of Six P Ct for Roads.

N.B. This Survey appears (Formerly) to have been made by Wm. Scull, & part of it is included in a Survey made for Pheby Shoemaker by Jonathan Lodge, as will appear by Pheby Shoemakers Return, the original Field notes on this Survey is prior to that of Shoemakers &c.
