



A Draught of a tract of Land surveyed the 8<sup>th</sup> day of October 1807, by virtue of a warrant granted to Gasper Ricketts for 100 acres of Land, dated the 25<sup>th</sup> day of June 1807, situate on Daniels Run a branch of the North Fork of Ten mile Creek in West Bethlehem Township Called Scraps, Containing one hundred four acres ten perches together with the usual allowance of six P<sup>ct</sup> Cent for Floods &c.
