



The above survey has been surveyed and returned by Alexander McClean Esq. late D.S. to the Surveyor Generals Office in pursuance of a Warrant granted unto John Little dated the 9th day of August 1774 (and perhaps Patented) and whereas John Finch Senior claims the whole of the above survey by virtue of an old improvement and Purchase made by said Finch together with a continued Settlement on the premises for near 20 years past and now occupies the same, also in pursuance of a Warrant granted unto said Finch dated the 6th day of January 1765, Therefore the said John Finch Senior conceives himself aggrieved and requests a hearing before the Honorable the Board of Property in order to have a fair investigation of the dispute tryed with the Heirs of John Little deceas'd
