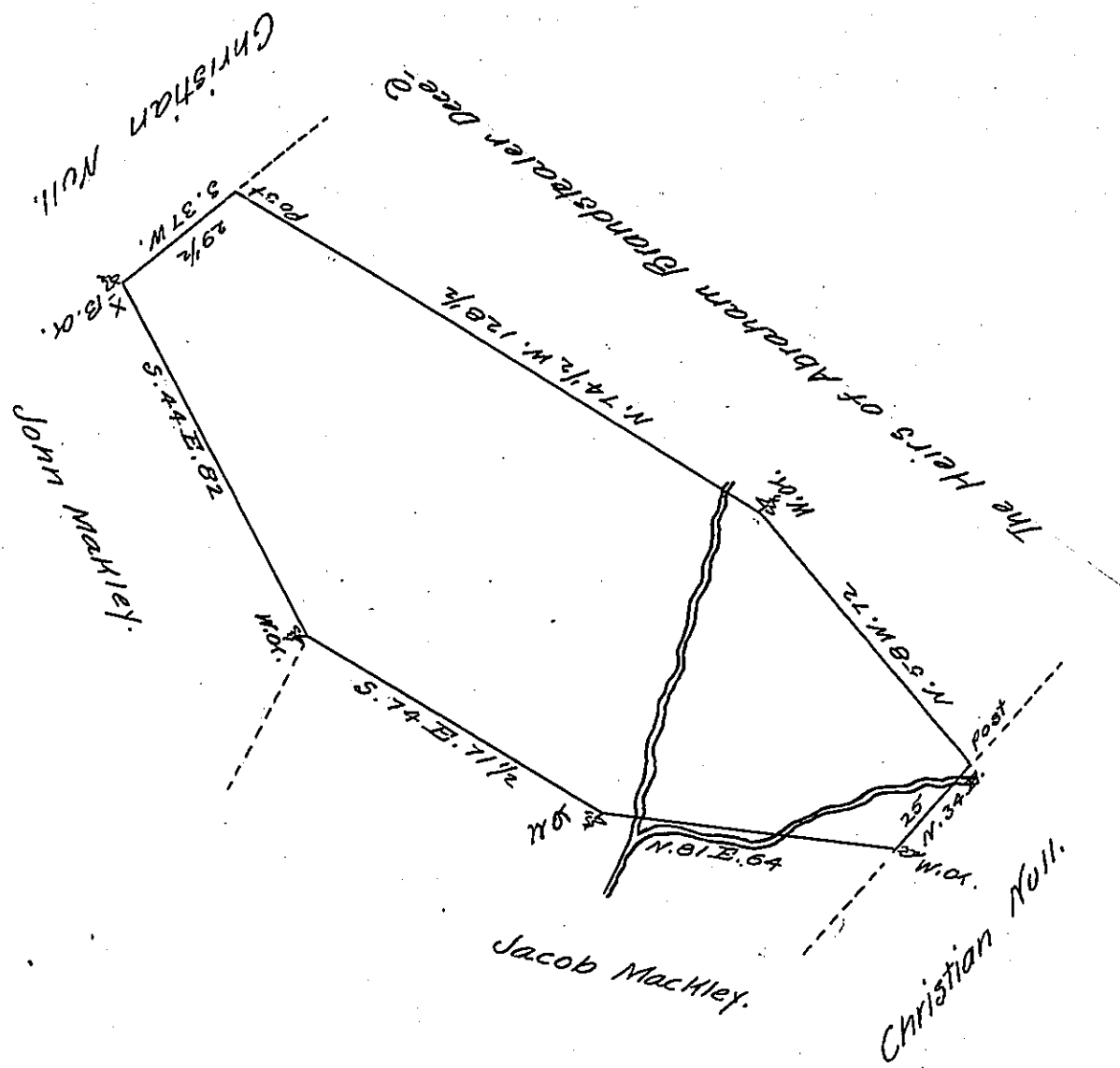

The above described Tract of Sixty five acres and a half and allowance of six Per Cent for Roads &c. situate in Londonderry Township Dauphin County (part of 285 acres and 21 perches and allowance) surveyed in one undivided Tract on Two Warrants, one in the name of Richard Robinson dated the 4th day of November 1747. the other in the Name of John Lehman dated the 30th day of April 1751. Surveyed and divided off this 4th day of November 1802 for the Heirs of John Sticklely Deceased.
