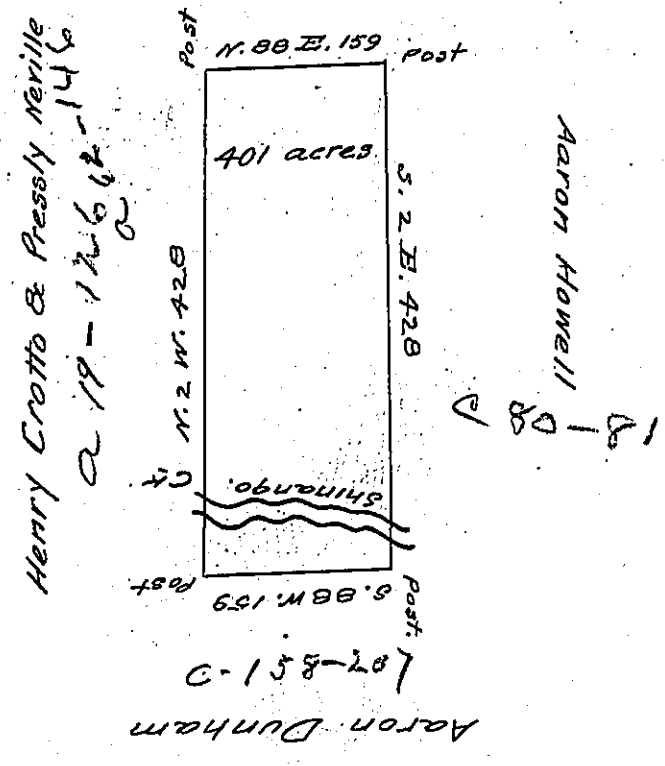


B. Stokelys District



The above is a draught of a survey made the 11<sup>th</sup> day of March 1795 in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Jonathan Fhea dated the 18<sup>th</sup> day of March 1794. Situated on the Waters of the Shenango branch of Beaver Creek in the third donation district in Allegheny County containing four hundred and one acres and allowance of six per Centum & call<sup>d</sup> Hanover.
