



A Draught of a tract of Land surveyed the 26th day of May 1808 in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Robert Falston for 130 acres of Land, dated the 10th day of July 1786, situate on the Waters of Chartiers Creek in Washington County called Pleasant Flat Containing Sixty five acres eighty one perches together with the usual allowance of six P^{ct} Cent for Roads.
