



By virtue of a Warrant granted to Peter Filley for forty acres of Land dated November 11th 1789, the above described Tract of Land containing twenty six acres & one hundred and twenty eight perches and the usual allowance of six Per Cent for Roads Situate on the waters of Ten Mile Creek in Bethlehem Township Washington County was surveyed the 24th day of May 1790, by John Hoge Esquire late Deputy Surveyor and now examined and Certified to be correct, this 30th day of May 1804 (called Surplusage)
