



By virtue of a warrant dated the fifteenth day of February Anno Domini 1742^{1/3} The above described Tract of land was surveyed unto Hans Jeriq Sparr in Erle Township in Lancaster County Beginning at a Corner of y^e land of Leonard Ailmaker thence S. 15 Deg^s West by y^e same 52 perches to a Black Oak then by the land of James Young E. S. E. 54 per^s to a White Oak and South 12 Degrees East 81 perches to a Black Oak thence East by North by Vacant land 84 perches to a Post in Andrew Caldwell's line then on y^e same and by vacant land N. by West 120 per to a Chesnut Oak then by Vact. land N. W. by W. 154 p^s to a White Oak and S. 40^o W. 38 P. to a post in said Ailmakers line yⁿ on y^e same S. E. 57 P. to y^e place of Beg. Cont^d 109^o & all^d 18th of 6 month 1743.
