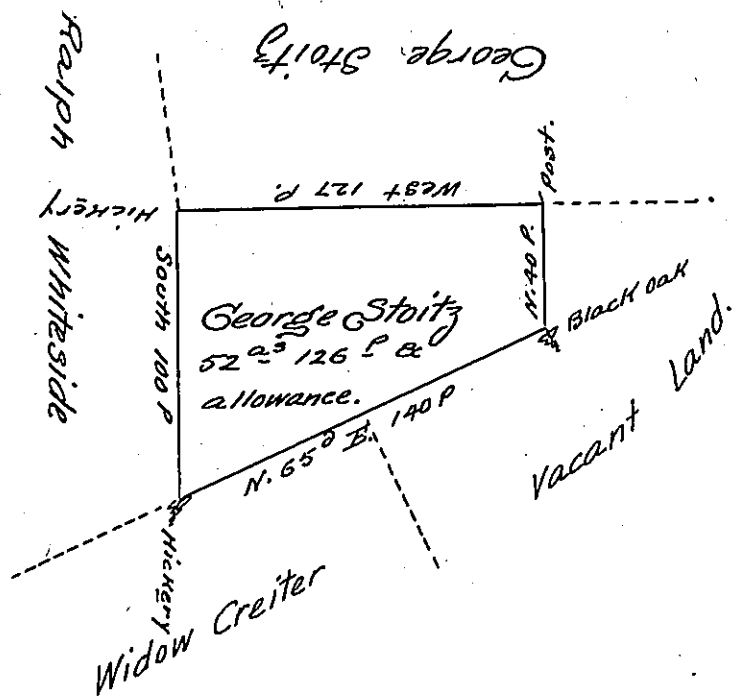

By virtue of a warrant from the Proprietor dated 17<sup>th</sup> day of March 1741 - The above described tract of land was surveyed to George Stoitz in Lancaster County and \_\_\_\_\_ Township Beginning at a Post in the line of his other land, thence West by D<sup>o</sup> 127 p. to a Hickery corner of Ralph Whiteside &c. Containing Fifty Two acres and one Hundred and Twenty six P<sup>s</sup> and the usual allowance. Surveyed 3<sup>rd</sup> 10<sup>mo</sup> 1742.
