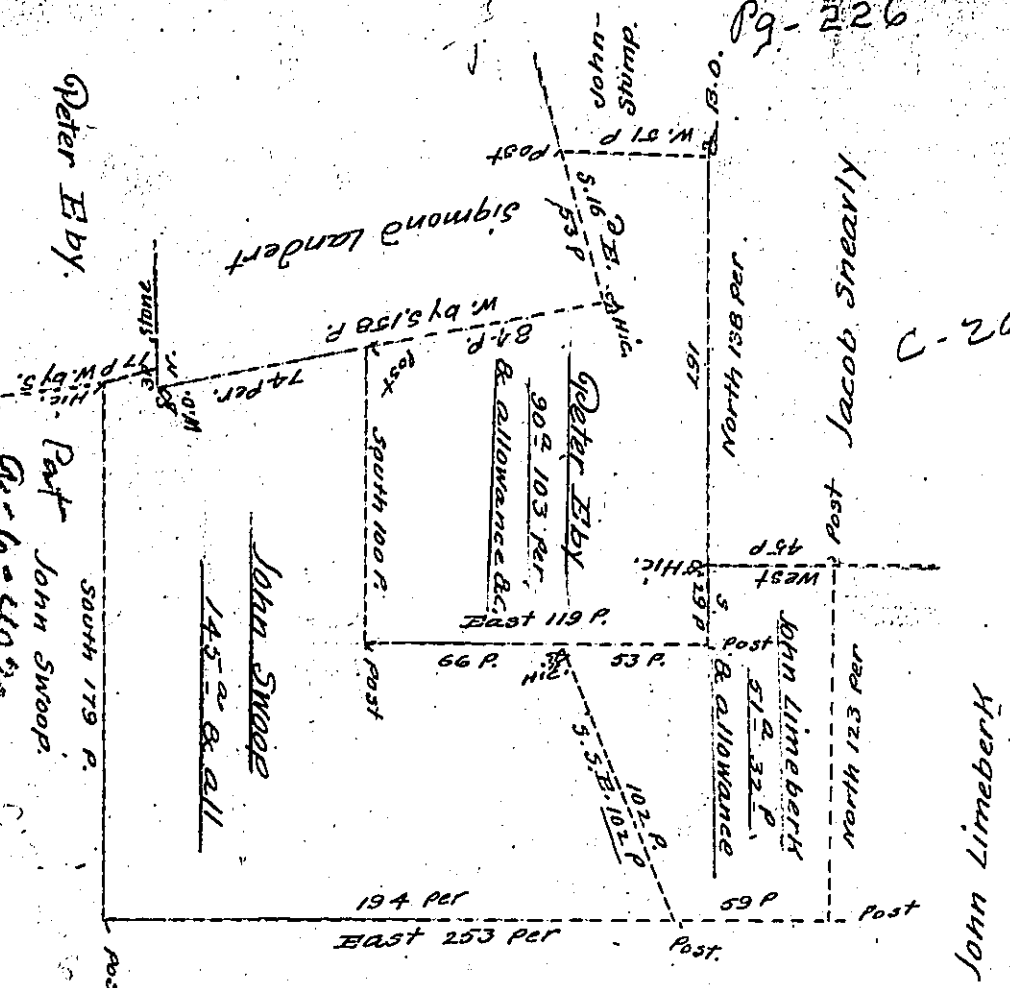

Divided into three parts as in the rough Draught above noted sur^d or Divided y^e 2^d 4th 1740

& the whole Tract above sur^d y^e 26th of y^e Same mo Teeter Eirod's Warrant was for 300^a dated the 19th of Jan^y 1733, but is now vacated & several warr^{ts} granted^d to John Schwob for 150, Peter Eby 100 more or less, John Limeberg 50 more or less, all these dated the 29th of 9^{ber} 1740 to pay interest from the 15th of July 1734

On the 2^d of y^e 4^{mo} Last I was informed that there is a warrant for the above land granted to one Teeter Eirod and three of the Neighbours adjoining nearly to y^e same purchased the Right of y^e present possessor and they being Persons y^t is likely to pay the Proprietor for the Land I made y^e survey & Divisions as above roughly set down which is all I can do at present being abroad but if occasion be please to examin this & I shall return fairer draught & thy fees I hope at more leisure.
