



The above described tract of land having been surveyed by Thomas Cookson late Deputy Surveyor in pursuance of a Warrant dated the 20th day of ^{March} ~~April~~ 1743 but the said Thomas Cookson not having made return of the survey in his life time and no entry to be found among his papers of the same - I was directed by Nicholas Scull Surveyor General to resurvey the said tract and make return thereof into his office which I have accordingly done this 14th day of Decem^r 1753 and find it bounded and limited as above described.
