



The above described tract of land having been surveyed by Thomas Cookson late Deputy Surveyor in pursuance of a Warrant dated the 28th day of April 1743: But said Thomas Cookson not having made return of the survey in his life time and no entry to be found among his papers of the same I was directed by Nicholas Scull Surveyor General to resurvey the said tract and make return thereof into his office which I have accordingly done this 14th day of December 1753 and find it bounded and limited as above described
