



By virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietaries dated the sixteenth day of September 1734 Surveyed unto Jacob Hubbaugh a tract of Land situate in Frederick Township in the County of Philad^a Beginning at white oak in a line of Paul Hyles land thence by the same South West thirty eight perches to a post thence by the lands of Frederick Rymer, Joseph Groves & Hans Sever North West one hundred and eighty perches to a post thence by Vacant land North east seventy seven perches to a Hickery a corner of John Harps land thence by the same South east eighty perches to a post thence by the said John Harps land South West thirty nine perches to a post thence by sd Harp South East one hundred perches to the place of Beginning Containing fifty eight acres with the usual allowance of Six P Cent. Surveyed Nov^r 5, 1734. By
