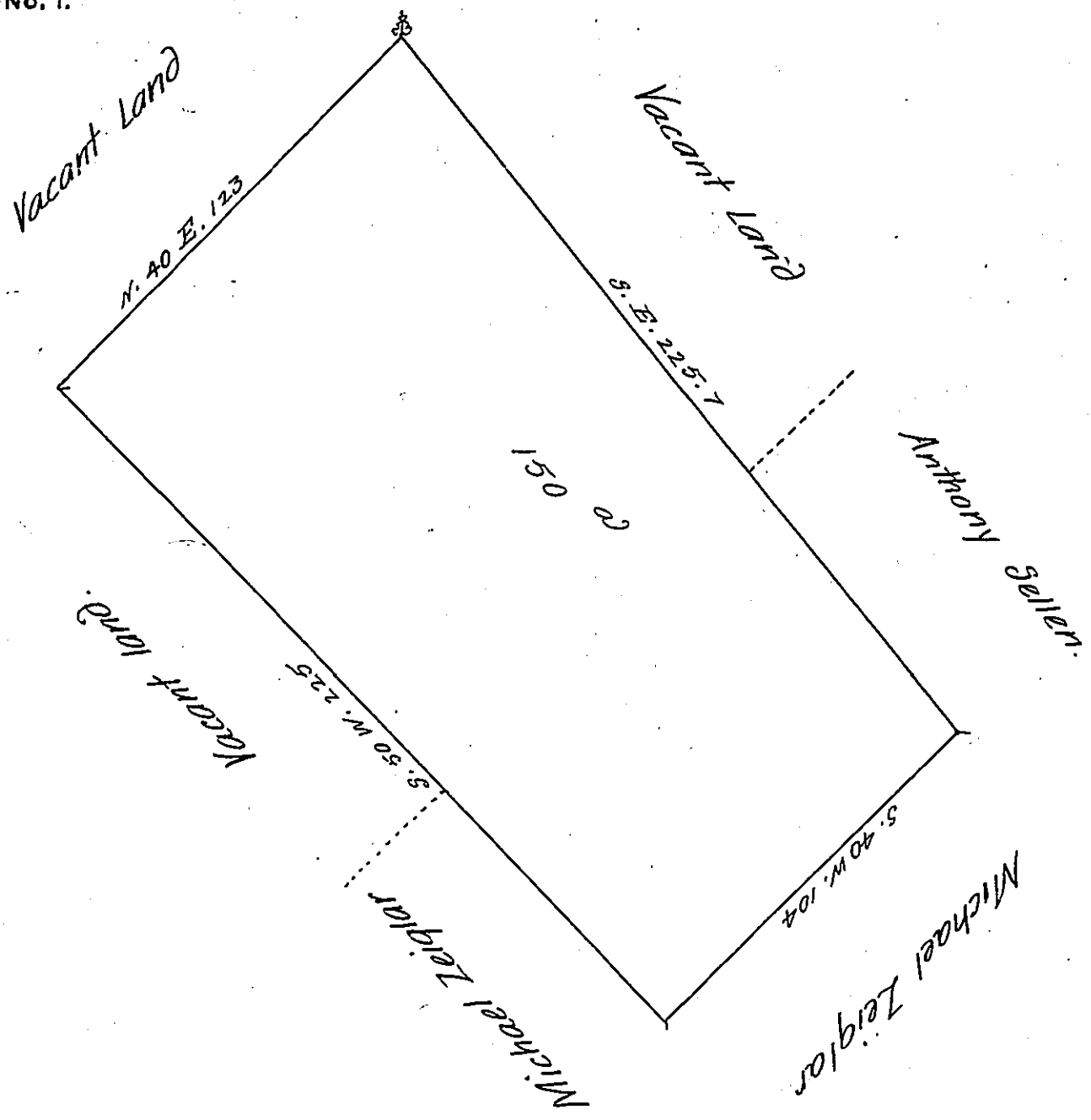

Surveyed to Hans Moyer on the 6th day of March 1733 a certain tract of Land situate in Cowisohoppin in the County of Philadelphia begining at a Post a corner of Michaels Zeiglar's land thence by the same North fifty Degrees West Eighty six perches to a Post thence the same Course by Vacant land one hundred and thirty nine perches to a Post thence by Vacant Land North forty, East one hundred twenty three perches to a small White Oak markt for a corner thence by Vacant land one hundred thirty nine perches and ^{8.7 tenths} by Anthony Sellens Land ye same Course Eighty six perches to a Post thence by land of Michael Zeiglar South forty Degrees West one hundred & four perches to the place of Begining Containing one hundred & fifty acres with usual allowance, Warr^t dated ye 5th of Feb. 1733.
