



A Plan of a Lot in the Town of York No 101 containing in Front on High Street Sixty five feet and in depth to a twenty feet Alley two hundred & thirty feet, bounded northward by the said Alley, Westward by a Lot, numbered on the general plan of the said Town 102, Southward by High Street and Eastward by Beaver Street Survey'd and laid out for Nicholas Stake the 4th day of November 1751, by order of the Hon^{ble} Proprietaries, and built on according to Covenant, the Right whereof is now vested in George Stevenson.
