



A Draft of a tract of land containing three hundred and sixty-six acres, 87.3 perches and allowance of six per cent for roads & c. situated in Henderson township, Huntingdon county, formerly Barree township, Bedford county. Surveyed the 23rd day of December, 1784. by George Woods, then Deputy Surveyor, in pursuance of a Warrant granted to James Reed, dated the 1st day of July, 1784.

Said survey re-examined, the 26th day of August, 1869, some errors corrected, and returned according to the original bearings, in pursuance of an order of the Board of Property granted to John Rhoads and James Hutchinson, dated the 11th day of August, 1869.
