



Situate on the west side of French Creek in Allegheny County containing 401 Acres 150  $\frac{1}{2}$  and allowance of Six pr Cent for Roads &  $\frac{1}{2}$  Resurveyed the 12<sup>th</sup> day of July 1799 In pursuance of a Warrant of 400 $\frac{1}{2}$  granted to Isaac Jones Bearing date the 30<sup>th</sup> day of May 1792 [It being the same tract of land which was surveyed the 6<sup>th</sup> day of November 1794 for Isaac Jone on his Improvement dated the 5<sup>th</sup> day of November 1794
